PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

This Privacy Policy governs the collection, use, and disclosure of personal information by True Trade Pro Ltd. ("Company"). It applies to all entities under the Company's umbrella and outlines how we gather, maintain, utilize, and protect personal information pertaining to our clients and visitors. This Policy is relevant to both existing and potential clients, as well as all visitors to the Company's website. 2. Collection of Personal Data

3.1 Retention of Personal Data

After this period, your data will be securely deleted or anonymized to ensure your privacy.

3.2 Data Minimization

We are committed to data minimization principles, meaning we will only collect personal data that is necessary for the purposes outlined in this Privacy Policy. We will not retain your personal data longer than necessary for these purposes.

4. Disclosure of Personal Data

The Company may be required to disclose your personal data to regulatory authorities and governmental entities as mandated by law. Your personal data may also be disclosed without prior notice in the following circumstances:

- a. **Legal Compliance**: To protect our rights or comply with legal proceedings.
- b. Fraud Prevention: To prevent potential fraud or unauthorized activities.



- c. **Legal Processes**: To comply with legal processes served to the Company, such as subpoenas or search warrants.
